Parenting Programs at Acorn Hill for children ages 0-2



Parenting an infant or toddler can be exciting and joyful, and it can be exhausting and emotionally challenging. Our classes offer gentle support and guidance, and foster a community of diverse families. As parents observe their babies during free movement and play, they gain a deeper insight and connection to their little ones. They experience the joy of being with their children as they “learn how to learn.”

Playtime is the backdrop for gross and fine motor development, and it is the beginning of 'pretend' play. During this play, we adults have to be careful with what we teach children—it might interfere with what they are learning! Our classes offer plenty of opportunities for social skills. Simple songs and games are introduced at circle time, and in the toddler classes, there is ample time spent outdoors.

Our Birth to Two classes are based on principles of Waldorf ECE, and the Pikler® & RIE® approach to infants and toddlers.
